# INTRODUCTION






- The Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) needn't be daunting!
- For many pupils, it's a fantastic opportunity for pupils to show off their fluency with their tables, which they've been practicing for years.





# WHAT IS THE MTC?



- 
- 
- The MTC stands for Multiplication Tables Check.
  - Set by the government, the MTC is an on-screen assessment designed to determine whether pupils are able to fluently recall their multiplication tables up to 12, through a set of timed questions.
- 

# MTC KEY FACTS.

- There is a 2-week check window starting 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2024 during which schools will complete the MTC with pupils in Year 4.
- Pupils will have 3 practice questions before the check begins.

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## MTC RESULTS



- After the MTC window closes, schools will be able to compare their school average, with their Local Authority and National average.

# PREPARING PUPILS : SCHOOL



- We *might* be spending a bit more time practising our times tables in class.
- Children *might* be set more times tables specific homework.
- We *might* be organising more class tournaments and asking pupils to play on Times Tables Rock Stars 15 minutes a week.

# PREPARING PUPILS : OUT OF SCHOOL



- Regular verbal times tables practice.
- Download the TTRS free app on to a home device.
- Play Times Tables Rock Stars 3 minutes a day.






**PEGI 3**

Games with a PEGI 3 rating are suitable for all ages.

They may have:

child-like settings

comical violence

language more suitable for young children

For example:

Just Dance

**PEGI 7**

Games with a PEGI 7 rating are suitable for ages 7 and above.

They may have:

some scenes or sounds that could be frightening

mild forms of violence (non-realistic or with no detail)

For example:

Minecraft

Roblox

**PEGI 12**

Games with a PEGI 12 rating are suitable for ages 12 and above.

They may have:

violence of a slightly graphic nature involving fantasy characters

suggestive activities or language

gambling

mild bad language

For example:

Sims

Fortnite

**PEGI 16**

Games with a PEGI 16 rating are suitable for ages 16 and above.

They may have:

violence and adult content that looks like real life

bad language

scenes demonstrating the use of tobacco, alcohol or illegal substances

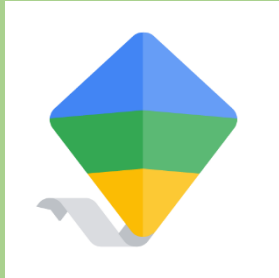

We aim to promote wellbeing and maintain a safe, secure and caring environment where everyone is treated with respect.

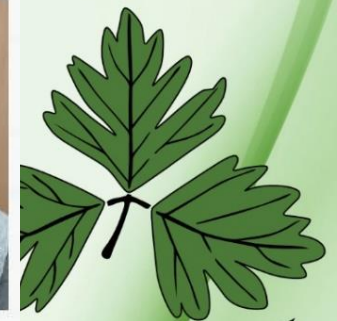
