Tiredness



Lice aren't Nice!

There has been a case of head lice in Oak class. Could we please ask you to check your child's hair using a fine-tooth comb on wet hair then comb through the hair in sections looking for eggs or lice. To treat:

- wet the hair and scalp with conditioner or over the counter solution. Using a fine metal comb or head lice comb go through the hair in sections to comb the lice and eggs out
- Always re-treat 7—10 days after the first treatment to kill any head lice that may have hatched from eggs that have survived the first treatment

Tips • Check hair every night • Please tie up long hair for school • Check and treat everyone in the family • Avoid sharing hairbrushes, towels or hats
