Your child will have their own yellow reading record and reading book sent home today. Please take time to read with them and share their book. Don't forget to log the reading!




Well done Ash and Oak Tree classes for a lovely week of learning!

Year 1/2 All of KS1 have learnt about the body this week. In Year 2, we drew around our bodies and labelled them. We then built them using junk modelling and discussed the

function of our body parts. In Year 1, the children have learnt the names of body parts and then built our own bodies out of cotton buds, then matched labels to the body parts. It was great fun doing an investigation to see what exercise would make our heart beat fast and what would make it beat














In year 2 we have been learning all about fact families and how to use addition and subtraction facts to solve number bonds to 20.
