# School Uniform Policy

At Badbury Park Primary School we want our children to look smart when at school and feel proud to wear their uniform. As a school with a focus on outdoor learning we also want our uniform to be practical and weather-proof. We have chosen to use an anemone leaf to become the school logo for Badbury Park, after being inspired by the work of Richard Jefferies. Richard Jefferies who was born in Swindon, was an ecologist and took inspiration from his surroundings, which fed into the texts that he wrote. The anemone leaf featured in many of Jefferies books, such as *'Round About a Great Estate'* and has since become the symbol for The Richard Jefferies Museum.

Our uniform policy is outlined below. We expect all our children to wear a school jumper or cardigan carrying our logo and these must be purchased online from PMG Schoolwear [https://pmsgschoolwear.co.uk/school/badbury\\_park\\_primary\\_school\\_\\_\\_swindon](https://pmsgschoolwear.co.uk/school/badbury_park_primary_school___swindon)

All other items can be purchased from any High Street store or supermarket.

### Main Uniform

- A black skirt, pinafore dress, shorts or trousers (not joggers)
- Green gingham summer dress
- A white polo shirt (with or without the school logo)
- A grey jumper or cardigan **with** the school logo
- Black tights or black or white socks (not coloured or patterned)
- Flat black shoes or smart black trainers with no obvious logo
- Waterproof coat that will fit in a locker

Our PTA sell and donate second-hand uniform at different times throughout the year and can be contacted via the school office.



### Nursery Uniform

Our Nursery children are required to wear a uniform when they attend their sessions. Please label each item of uniform.

- Grey tracksuit bottoms
- White polo shirt (with or without the school logo)
- School jumper or cardigan with the school logo
- Sensible black or grey footwear such as plimsols, plain trainers or daps

### PE Kit

A PE kit should be kept in school throughout the week and must consist of the following items:

- Black shorts (during the colder seasons, black tracksuit bottoms may be worn for outside games)
- A plain dark green t-shirt (with or without the school logo)
- Daps or trainers
- No jewellery
- Hair tied back
- No earrings (to be removed or covered)

Please note children need correct PE kit to be safe to take part in activities.



### Optional Items to Purchase

- A green book bag with the school logo embroidered to the front (with a shoulder strap)
- A green fleece, with the school logo
- A green sun hat, with the school logo (legionnaires or cap style)
- A green woolly hat, with the school logo
- A green PE bag, with the school logo

- Water bottle

### **Hair, Jewellery and accessories**

- No jewellery allowed except for a watch (no smart watches) and only small, plain studs if children have pierced ears. These need to be covered with tape during PE.
- Watches – to be analogue or digital. No smart watches.
- Hair accessories are to be kept to a discreet minimum and in back or green - neither large bows nor headbands with decorative pieces are allowed.
- Religious head coverings should be plain grey, black or dark green
- Nail varnish should not be worn in school.
- Natural hair colours
- Long hair tied back

### **Other items**

- Children need a waterproof coat for school, school bag ,bottle, wellies and waterproof trousers during Forest School term and during the Foundation stage. In the summer a sunhat – all to be provided from home and named.



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
