As many people will already be aware, the team at Koalas (the charity run opportunity group for children with SEND) has moved into Swindon Borough Council to be part of the Early Years Quality and Inclusion team (EYQI team).

Following lots of very creative suggestions from parents and staff, a shortlist of possible new names for the Koalas sessions was drawn up. More than 170 responses to the survey the new name of "Explorers" was chosen. We would like to thank everyone who was involved in suggesting names and voting for them, the response has been overwhelming!

The Portage and Special Tots services have also moved into the EYQI team, along with the Explorers service, to form the new 'Specialist Early Years Centre'.


