### Reception









At the start of the week we talked about the exciting event from the weekend - the King's Coronation. The children enjoyed sharing what they had seen and liked and we spent time doing lots of activities related to the coronation. They wrote descriptions of the King and decided what they would do if they were a King or Queen for the day. We have been very busy continuing to learn about space and using moon dust and moon sand to write messages! We also learnt to write an acrostic poem for space.

<u>Year 1/2</u>: Year 1 and 2 have had a wonderful time celebrating the King's Coronation! We made crowns, flags, wands and baked delicious goodies, which we shared together in the hall before inviting our parents in for a (very rainy!) rendition of the National Anthem.











Yew Tree class enjoyed a morning of computing last week, exploring on the VR headsets, revisiting time outside with the Spheros and using the iPads to research Mary Anning, our significant person for history.



**Year 3**: In Science, the children have explored the different layers of soil by creating their very own dirt pudding. Each layer of the rather unusual dessert represented a different layer of soil found beneath us. For English, we have been creating and writing our own persuasive adverts for readers to visit Coate Water. The children used their first-hand knowledge alongside further research to generate curiosity, and find out information and activities about Coate Water – they have all

produced a wonderful piece of writing. For Maths, we have finished our learning for now on fractions and begun learning about mass, focusing on reading scales. Alongside this, we have had some hands-on problem solving linked to

number. During Forest School we have created miniature gardens and made model swings out of string, branches and small pieces of wood which the children have thoroughly enjoyed. In addition, we have revisited key parts of Spanish to revise greetings, numbers, age and colours. Finally for our Stone Age topic, we have looked at food sources during the Palaeolithic and Mesoli

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### Changes to the lunch menu and ordering process




We welcomed Mrs Biggs this week as the very first Catering Manager of Badbury Park Primary and Nursery School. Mrs Biggs is currently creating a new menu and setting up our own kitchen so that we can provide meals to Badbury pupils which will be cooked freshly in-house from **Tuesday 6th June.** We have listened to the replies from our parent survey and Mrs Biggs will be re-introducing a bigger choice of desserts (e.g. mini muffins, flapjack, etc.) plus a school packed lunch choice every day which will include items such as wraps

and baguettes. The new menu will be available to view next week.

We are taking this opportunity to change the way in which meals are booked and paid for (for children in nursery and Year 3). From 24th may, you will need to log on to your **My Child at School** portal where you will see the possibility of booking meals and clubs. Moving to MCAS will mean everything is now in one place for your child, no switching from one system to another, and you will be able to see a record of everything you have booked. School office staff will also be able to see what parents can see so we will be able to support you more efficiently.

We will be sending out a detailed user guide next week but essentially meals can be booked by selecting the 
"dinner detail" section from the dashboard—please see example below. As with our current process, all meals 
need to be booked by Wednesday the week before lunch is required (e.g. for lunches required from 6th June 
onwards, bookings need to be booked by Wednesday 24th May.



All clubs and trips will also be booked in the same way by selecting the item from the MCAS dashboard.

If you have any debts outstanding on Parentpay please clear this by 26th May. Any credit on Parentpay will either be refunded, or in the case of childcare vouchers, carried over to My Child at School



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### After School Club

As you will know from previous communications, the management of our After School Club will be taken over by The Big A from the new academic year on 6th September (sessions will be 3pm-4pm or 3pm-6pm). This is in response to requests from parents to offer longer hours and the capacity to offer many more places. Although the Big A will be based in our school, this is an independently

run club and all bookings, payments and gueries will need to made directly to staff via the Big A website; it will not be possible for Badbury Park school staff to make any after school club bookings on your behalf. would like any additional information, and to register your child in preparation for bookings from September, please go to the Big A website as detailed here: https://www.thebigaclub.co.uk/after-school-club/

Bookings for After School club from 6th June to 25th July only can be made on the My Child at School app (detailed guidance will be sent next week) from 24th May.

### Year 3 Orienteering club— 6th June -18th July

There are still spaces available in our exciting new orienteering club for Year 3 pupils which takes place every Tuesday in Term 6 from 3.15-4.15pm.

Orienteering is an exciting outdoor adventure sport similar to a cross-country race. The difference is that it involves walking or running while navigating around a course. Participants use a detailed map, and sometimes a compass, rather than following a set course. They have to reach set control points along the way. The aim is to complete the course in the guickest time. This means competitors need to choose their route and plan it carefully.

If your child is interested in taking part, please let the school office know as soon as possible.
